Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.84 dated 30.10.2015, registered under Section 498-A IPC and Section 3 of the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe (Prevention of Atrocities) Act 1989 at Police Station Islamabad, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 18.12.2015, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has cooperated.

Learned State counsel on instructions has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 18.12.2015 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made

absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub
