The prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner/accused-Kulwinder Kaur @ Bholi in case FIR No.114 dated 14.11.2015, under Sections 420, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station City Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib (**Annexure P-1**).

A complaint was filed by seven daily wagers by stating that the present petitioner/accused-Kulwinder Kaur @ Bholi had posed herself as to be an Officer of the A.D.C. Office at Sri Muktsar Sahib and could arrange a dairy loan for them within 40 days upon payment of 10% charges.

The petitioner/accused is alleged to have received a sum of Rs.3 Lacs from the complainants.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Mohinder Singh, submits that although the petitioner has joined the investigation, however, she is not cooperating in the proceedings.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence committed by the petitioner qua poor persons, no case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
