This is third application for grant of regular bail in a case registered against the petitioner and his co-accused Sanjay who had fired at police officials. Pistol and two live cartridges in magazine were recovered with one cartridge in the chamber.

So far as the petitioner is concerned, he has not been attributed any injury to the police officials. The material witnesses of the police have already been examined. The petitioner has been in custody with effect from 07.11.2014. Chances of tampering with the evidence are remote.

Taking into consideration, the period of detention and the stage of the trial the petitioners can be granted the concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond/surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
