JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Present 2nd petition under Section 167(2) Cr.P.C. read with Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner-Avtar Singh in case FIR No.54 dated 27.05.2015, under Sections 22/21/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered with Police Station Bajakhana, District Faridkot.

There is a alleged recovery of 350 intoxicating tablets of Alprafresh and 80 grams of intoxicating powder from the petitioner.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 27.05.2015.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has become infructuous in the light of the default bail under Section 167(2) Cr.P.C. having been granted to the petitioner/accused.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
