This order of mine shall dispose of two criminal petitions bearing CRM-M Nos.42787 and 43141 of 2015, being the version and cross version.

Both the petitions have been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.187, dated 21.11.2015, under Sections 323, 324, 34, registered at Police Station Kartarpur,

District Jalandhar and its cross version registered vide DDR No.31,

dated 22.11.2015, registered under Sections 323, 324, 452, 148 and 149 IPC along with all consequential proceedings arising there from.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jalandhar has been received to the effect that the statements of both the parties have been recorded. It is reported that the parties have entered into a compromise and that the same is voluntary and without any pressure.

Since, the matter has been amicably settled between the parties, therefore, the FIR No.187, dated 21.11.2015, under Sections 323, 324, 34, registered at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar and its cross version registered vide DDR No.31, dated 22.11.2015, registered under Sections 323, 324, 452, 148 and 149 IPC along with all consequential proceedings arising there from stand quashed.

Both the aforesaid petitions stand allowed accordingly.
