The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for directing the respondent Nos. 2 and 3 for taking action on the representation filed by the petitioner herein.

The petitioner was married on 22.01.1996 to respondent No. 4 and out of this wedlock two children were born. The petitioner and respondent No. 4 have been residing happily since the year 2007 on account of the fact that there were irrevocable differences between them. It is alleged that petitioner herein had made a complaint against respondent No. 4 regarding stealing of her gold ornaments. However, the same has not been investigated. A copy of the complaint dated 11.11.2016 is annexed as Annexure P-1 and Annexure P-2 with this petition. The relief as sought for in this petition is that complaint/representation dated 11.11.2016 should be acted upon by the police officials against respondent No. 4.
