Petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.264 dated 24.09.2014, registered at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala, under Section(s) 306, 34 IPC.

At the very outset, learned State counsel, on instructions, has informed this Court that the petitioners have joined the investigation on 06.05.2016 and they are no longer required for any further interrogation.
