JUSTICE M.M.S. BEDI, JUDGE (ORAL)

This order will dispose of the aforesaid three applications for grant of regular bail filed by petitioners Harish Kumar, Kavita Sharma and Baldev Singh, respectively.

The allegations against the petitioners are that the petitioners indulged in the activities of taking money and appearing as surety in judicial Courts at Mansa by using fake *Jamabandis*.

The allegations against the petitioners are very serious but in view of the fact that they have been in custody with effect from June/July, 2015; and challan having already been filed, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court with a condition that petitioners will be blacklisted for the purpose of appearing as surety or guarantor in any case.

In case, the petitioners indulge in similar activity at Mansa/Bathinda or any other Court in Punjab and Haryana, the present order will be liable to be cancelled. The names of the petitioners be notified to the Courts at Bathinda/Mansa to debar them from appearing as surety. Their appearance as surety in bail matters is prohibited.

Before releasing the petitioners, they would be required to furnish an affidavit with the trial Court that they will not commit the similar offence of which they are accused of in the present FIR. Petitioners will be released on bail subject to the above said conditions.

Petitions are allowed with aforesaid observations.
