Prayer is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.22 dated 20.01.2006 under Sections 15/61/85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act at Police Station Sadar Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur.

The petitioner was on bail when he had absented himself from the Court proceedings on 29.9.2012. He was declared a proclaimed offender on 29.4.2013 and was arrested by the police on 25.3.2015. The prayer for grant of bail is based on the fact that the rest of the co-accused have since been acquitted and the petitioner is in custody since last more than ten months.

After hearing counsel for the petitioner, no case for grant of regular bail is made out in view of the conduct of the petitioner, which has unnecessarily delayed the trial qua him.

Dismissed.
