Prayer in this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the accused persons, namely, Ashwani Kumar, Kamal Pal, Gaurav Bhandari, Ranjit Singh, Vikash Kumar alias Vikash Sharma and Sunil Kumar (petitioner Nos. 1 to 6, respectively, herein) is for quashing of FIR No. 153, dated 27.10.2015, for offences punishable under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 473 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar Rural as well as subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Allegation against present petitioners are that they were involved in impersonating as Army Officers with fake stamps of Military Department and would cheat unsuspecting persons by receiving huge amounts on the pretext of securing them jobs in the Military. They are also alleged to be using vehicles with false and fake documents and fake number plates.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
