The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No.184 dated 22.03.2014 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station City Ballabgarh, District Faridabad.

On instructions from ASI Balbir Singh, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined investigation but he did not co-operate. However, neither learned State counsel nor the Investigating Officer who is present is able to explain how the petitioner had not co-operated during investigation.

Accordingly, there remains nothing to be recovered from the petitioner as it is submitted that the complainant had already compromised the matter with the main accused, the interim order dated 12.12.2016 is hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner will join the

investigation as and when required by the police and will not tamper with evidence or hamper the investigation and will not leave the country without permission of the Court.
