The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking interim temporary bail for three days in FIR No.33 dated 20.01.2016 registered under Section 302 & 201 IPC at Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar, for attending marriage of sister's son.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

Vide order dated 08.07.2016 passed in CRM-M-22048-2016 the petitioner was allowed similar interim bail order for attending marriage of his own daughter.

Learned State counsel submits that he has reported back to jail.

Having regard to the fact that the petitioner has come back to the jail after above order, I think the petitioner can be given three days interim bail. Hence, I make the following order:-

ORDER

- (i) The CRL. MISC. No.M-43867 OF 2016 is allowed.
- (ii) The petitioner shall be released on interim bail on the terms and conditions to be imposed by the trial Court. The order shall be

effective from the actual date of release for the period of three days.

- (iii) The petitioner shall thereafter surrender before Police Station Nangloi, Delhi West.
