This is a petition which has been filed under Section 439

Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.160

dated 12.05.2016, registered under Sections 188, 379, 307, 427, 34 IPC

and Sections 25, 54, 59 of the Arms Act (Sections 120-B & 285 IPC added later on), at Police Station Nangal Chaudhary, District Mahendergarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in custody since 17.05.2016 and the invocation of offence under Section 307 IPC is a debatable issue.

Learned Deputy Advocate General has accepted the assertion of custody period but states that many similar cases are pending against him.

Be that as it may, keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. Ordered accordingly. Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
