SNEH PRASHAR, J.

The instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for issuance of direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, which is stated to be in danger at the hands of respondent No.4 to 7 and also not to harass and humiliate them at the behest of the said respondents.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that the petitioners had given a friendly loan of Rs.4 lacs to Baldev Singh, which was not repaid by him. Only to put pressure on them, they are being called time and again by the police to compromise the matter. So far no criminal case is registered against them.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the police that in case, the petitioners are required to be summoned for any enquiry, a notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. be given to them.
