Present petition is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner in case FIR No.307 dated 15.09.2012 for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 474 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Tripari Town, Tehsil and District Patiala (**Annexure P-2**).

The owner-Luxmi Devi is alleged to have executed three sale deeds pertaining to the same land. The petitioner is the son of the said accused Luxmi Devi and was attesting witness in the first sale deed executed in favour of accused Atul Mittal and his mother-Nirmala Devi. Second sale deed dated 06.10.2009 was executed in favour of the complainant-Rimple. Third sale deed was executed on 29.01.2010 in favour of the same accused Atul Mittal. The said accused-Atul Mittal is further alleged to have raised loans from different banks on the basis of separate sale deeds.

The petitioner was declared proclaimed offender on 03.09.2014 and was arrested by the police on 20.08.2015. He has already succeeded in delaying the criminal trial.

At this stage, learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused wishes to withdraw the present petition.
