Prayer is under Section 439 Cr.PC for grant of regular bail to the petitioner Seema in case FIR No.114 dated 12.09.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 365 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Division No.4, Jalandhar.

As per allegations surfaced in the investigation, present accused-Seema along with her step daughter Jyoti had lifted a new born child from the Civil Hospital and sold it to co-accused Rekha for a sum of Rs.25,000/-.

It is contended that the only role attributed to the petitioner is of having accompanying Jyoti, who is the one who has lifted the child.

Petitioner is stated to be not involved in any other case and in custody since 16.09.2015. Investigations qua him are over and challan has been presented.

Learned State Counsel assisted by ASI Balwinder Singh does not dispute the role attributed to the petitioner, custody period and the fact of presentation of challan.

Without going into the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period, petitioner being a lady and the fact that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future, present petition is allowed and the petitioner Seema is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of learned CJM/Duty Magistrate, Jalandhar.

Petition stands disposed of.
