TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in complaint case No.6565/2013 dated 27.08.2013, under Sections 406/420/506 IPC titled as Jagjit Singh vs. Amarjit Singh & others pending in the Court of Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Kapurthala.

On 24.12.2015, while issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court:

“CRM-42138 of 2015

This application is for placing on record zimni orders as Annexure A-1 collectively.

Application is allowed and Annexure A-1 Collectively is taken on record.

CRM-M-42989 of 2015

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in the case. As per allegations in the complaint, no offence is made out under Sections 406, 420 and 506 IPC. The petitioners are ready to

join the Court proceedings.

Notice of motion for 26.02.2016.

Meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to surrender before the trial Court within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and in case, they surrender before the trial Court, they shall be released on interim bail on their furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.”

Counsel appearing for the petitioners has produced in Court today certified copies of the orders dated 05.01.2016 and 06.01.2016 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Kapurthala and which would reflect that the petitioners have duly appeared before the trial Court and have been admitted to bail on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount each.

The petitioners having already joined trial proceedings, prayer made in the present petition is accepted.

Petition is allowed. Order dated 24.12.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.
