The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 111 dated 17.08.2015 registered at Police Station Kharar, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) under Sections 304-B, 34 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that Kajal was married to Satpal in December 2008 and the FIR had been registered in 2015 and there were no injuries on the body of the deceased and Viscera report has yet to come.

Learned State counsel submits that an alternative charge under Section 302 IPC had been framed.

The petitioner is 71 years old and is the mother-in-law of the deceased. The deceased had been married for almost 7 years when the unfortunate incident took place. The deceased had a 6 years old son. There were no injuries in the postmortem report.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
