Report dated 16.05.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar has been received, whereby, after recording statement of petitioner Satbir Singh as well as of complainant Harjit Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is case of non-injury and that the parties have effected a compromise for the offences which are not of heinous nature which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.12 dated 25.01.2014 under Section 27 of Arms Act, Police Station, Kamboj, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar and all

other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.

Petition stands disposed off.
