Reply to the application by way of short affidavit has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record. Copy thereof has also been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that claim of the petitioner has already been considered and decided in view of Punjab Government instructions dated 23.7.1957. As per office order dated 3.7.2015, the petitioner has been found entitled for notional pay fixation and his pay has also been re-fixed accordingly by the respective Management. Learned State counsel also submits that necessary relief of revised pension has also been granted to the petitioner vide order dated 10.10.2016 (Annexure R-2).

In view of submissions made by learned State counsel and the stand taken in para 5 of the short affidavit, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.
