TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)

This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.97 dated 27.06.2015, under Sections 325/323/324/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code (Section 308 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar Rural.

While issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court on 19.12.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that apart from the fact that it is cross-version case, the occurrence had taken place on 10.6.2015 whereas the instant FIR was registered on 27.6.2015. She further submits that initially, the case was registered under Section 325/323/324/148/149 IPC but Section 308 IPC has been added later on.

Notice of motion for 11.3.2016.

In the meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on ad interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer. However, he shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) CrPC.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Shamsher Singh would apprise the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation on 20.01.2016 and there is no recovery to be effected from him.

In view of the above, prayer made in the present petition is accepted.

Order dated 19.12.2015, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
