The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.416 dated 21.10.2015 (Annexure P1) under Section 420 IPC registered at Police Station Central Sector 17, Chandigarh along with all the consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise dated (Annexure P2).

Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Chandigarh received. Statements of both the parties were recorded. It is reported that the parties have compromised the matter and the same is without any fear or undue influence. It was a money dispute between the parties.

Since the matter has been amicably settled, therefore, FIR No.416 dated 21.10.2015 (Annexure P1) under Section 420 IPC registered at Police Station Central Sector 17, Chandigarh, along with all the consequential proceedings stands quashed.

The petition stands allowed.
