The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of concession of regular bail in case based on First Information Report No.13 dated 20.01.2015 under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drgus and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'NDPS') registered at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur.

Learned State counsel has filed affidavit of Sh. Ajmer Singh, Superintendent, Central Jail, Ferozepur showing the custody period of petitioner which is taken on record.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the allegation against the petitioner is that 840 tablets of Alprazolam were recovered from him. The petitioner is running a licensed chemist shop in the name and style M/s Harnoor Medical Hall. The licence has been placed on record as Annexure P-2. As per the report of chemical examiner, each capsule contained the drug i.e. Alprazolam to the extent of 0.123 grams and

accordingly the weight of the total contraband recovered comes to slightly higher than the commercial quantity. The final report has already been submitted before learned trial Court.

In view of the above facts and circumstances and without going into the merits, as the trial will take some time to complete and there is no plausible ground to detain the petitioner further in custody, he is ordered to be released on regular bail during pendency of the trial, on his furnishing bail/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.
