FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

The allegations against the petitioners in this regular bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. are that they happened to be employees of accused-company M/s Shalimar Estates Pvt. Ltd. being run by Mr. R.K. Aggarwal, Director of the Company and that the accused-company had duped almost Rs.70 Crores from 112 investors on fraudulent pretext of allotting commercial establishments which they did not do leading to registration of an FIR.

The contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners are mere employees of the accused-company and had no role to play in the affairs of the company neither were beneficiaries and had only carried on their office duty are not controverted by learned State counsel

In view thereof and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 12.10.2016 and that the very allegations on the

part of the petitioners in the commission of crime certainly could not be discerned from the Police record and that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioners behind the bars, without adverting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition for grant of regular bail is allowed. Petitioners be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
