The petitioner has filed instant petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.117, dated 22.06.2015, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Sadar, Patiala, District Patiala.

The learned counsel for the petitioner(s) states that the present FIR is the counter blast to the earlier civil litigation going on between the parties. In pursuance of the order dated 19.12.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel as well as the learned counsel

for the complainant submit that the petitioner(s) in conspiracy with other co-accused prepared false and fabricated Will of Yashodha Devi. He was a party to an agreement dated 04.04.2001.

Heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

There are specific allegations against the petitioner that he in connivance with co-accused has executed an agreement to sell dated 04.04.2001 on the basis forged and fabricated documents. The petitioner is one of the beneficiary of the alleged fraud. Keeping in view the accusation of fraud and impersonation against the petitioner (s), this Court feels that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is necessary to unearth the actual picture.

Dismissed.
