Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that the petitioners have directly approached this Court for interim bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. He further submits that petitioners apprehend their arrest since the charge sheet has been filed and summons (Annexures P-9 and P-10) have been issued.

In view of the above, I think that the petitioners should be extended the benefit of protection from arrest only for 5 days in order to enable them to approach the trial Court for consideration for relief of grant of anticipatory bail. This order shall not influence the learned judge in the matter.
