This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.04 dated 01.01.2012, under Section 395 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar Rural.

While issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court on 08.02.2016:-

"Petitioner seeks concession of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.04 dated 01.01.2012, under Section 395 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar Rural.

Counsel would submit that the petitioner is facing trial in a case where accusations are of having committed dacoity of Rs.6000/-. It is contended that the

petitioner had all through associated with the trial proceedings and only on account of non-appearance on 07.12.2015, the concession of bail already granted has been cancelled and his bail bonds and surety bonds have been forfeited.

It is contended that non-appearance on 07.12.2015 was on account of bona fide reasons i.e. ill health of the petitioner since he was suffering from Typhoid and the intent was never to evade trial proceedings.

Notice of motion, returnable for 04.05.2016.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on the date already fixed i.e. 11.02.2016. In the eventuality of his doing so, he would be entitled to interim bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Som Lal would apprise the Court that the petitioner duly appeared before the trial Court on 11.02.2016 and was admitted to interim bail on furnishing requisite bail bonds.

The petitioner having joined trial proceedings, prayer made in the present petition is accepted.

Petition is allowed. Order dated 08.02.2016, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
