The instant petition has been preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.200 dated 26.07.2016, registered under Sections 364A, 342, 120-B, 323 and 397 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station City, Khanna, Distt. Ludhiana.

Contents that the petitioner has been in custody since 26.07.2016. Co-accused Ramandeep Kaur and Jagpreet Singh, have already been released on bail.

On the other hand learned State counsel has opposed the present petition. It is informed that the challan has been presented and the matter is now fixed for framing of charges.

Heard.

Considering the fact that co-accused Ramandeep Kaur and Jagpreet Singh have already been released on bail; the petitioner is in custody since 26.07.2016; and though the challan has been presented but the charges are yet to be framed, therefore, it can safely be inferred that the trial

is not likely to be concluded in the near future; without adverting to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

However, anything noticed hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
