The petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to constitute an SIT comprising of Senior officers so as to comprehensively investigate case FIR No.241 dated 07.09.2016, registered under Sections 341, 336, 506, 34 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Sultanwind, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar and bring the culprits of heinous offence to justice.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in this connection the petitioner have also moved a representation (Annexure P-6) and at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.3-Addl. Director General of Police (Security), Punjab to look into the matter and take appropriate action on his representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.3- Addl.

Director General of Police (Security), Punjab is directed to look into the matter and in case it is found that any action is required, to take whatever action he deems necessary as per law.
