JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 76, dated 12.06.2015, under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, Police Station Khamano, District Fatehgarh Sahib and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 08.12.2015 (Annexure P-2).

2. In compliance of order dated December 22, 2015, report of Id. Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that compromise arrived at between the parties apparently appears to be a genuine compromise and is the

voluntary act of the parties without there being any sort of pressure or coercion from any corner. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 76, dated 12.06.2015, under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, Police Station Khamano, District Fatehgarh Sahib and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
