SUDIP AHLUWALIA, J

The allegation against accused persons named in the FIR is that after having obtained loan for purchase of a vehicle, they allegedly misappropriated the amount towards payment of other debts/liabilities. Material available on the CD so far does not indicate that any document issued from their side has been verified as being fake.

On the other hand, it is the submission of learned counsel for the petitioners at the bar that the vehicle in question is in physical custody of his clients and that they are willing to cooperate with the investigation and also to produce the vehicle in question before the Investigating Officer/Court as and when required.

In the given circumstances, this petition is disposed of with the observation that the petitioners shall be released on bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Phagwara, after their surrender within a period of one week from today.

They shall undertake to comply with the requisite formalities of Section 438

(2) Cr.P.C. and shall also produce the vehicle in question as and when required.
