Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner-Ravi Shekher in case FIR No.322 dated 7.9.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 420, 405 Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Sushant Lok, Gurgaon.

As per allegations petitioner-accused is one of the Directors of a company under the name and style of M/s Beverly Tower Ltd., engaged in dealing with real estate business. Petitioner is alleged to have induced many investors to buy flats in Sector 99/102, Gurgaon and accepted amounts without there being any land purchased or construction undertaken.

It is contended that the petitioner himself has been duped by the

construction company with whom he had tied up for the construction.

At the time of hearing and grant of interim protection on 24.12.2015, the petitioner had filed his undertaking by way of affidavit dated 23.12.2015 committing to repay a sum of Rs.30 lacs to the aggrieved complainants by way of installments in a scheduled manner which is as under:-

- “
1. 6 lakhs on January 29th 2016.
 2. 8 lakhs on February 29th 2016.
 3. 8 lakhs on March 31st 2016.
 4. 8 lakhs on April 29th 2016.
- ”

Learned State Counsel assisted by ASI Subash Chander submits that after filing of the undertaking a sum of Rs.6 lacs only has been paid till today.

At this stage, learned Counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
