JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Present petition is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner in case FIR No.100 dated 27.08.2015 for offences punishable under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Balongi, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

The marriage between the deceased-Urmila and the petitioner/accused-Surya Pal was solemnized on 24.02.2008 and out of the wedlock, a son and a daughter were born.

As per the allegations, the petitioner used to give regular beatings to the deceased-Urmila and on the fateful day fed up with a quarrel and such beatings, she jumped from the roof top, resulting into her death.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 27.08.2015.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by SI Charanjit Singh, states that charges have been framed and there are 10 cited prosecution witnesses.

After arguing for sometime, learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

It is hoped that the prosecution would expedite the adducing of its evidence.
