This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.279 dated 26.10.2009 under sections 379 and 188 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Tauru, District Mewat.

The allegations against the petitioner are to the effect that he was the Cleaner on a Dumper Truck which was carrying stones having been quarried without any valid mining license.

F.I.R was registered in the year 2009.

Apparently, the petitioner had absented himself from the court proceedings in the year 2011 and thereafter he has been declared a Proclaimed Offender. Be that as it may, it has gone uncontroverted that main accused Salim has since been acquitted by the Trial Court.

Petitioner has been in custody since 7.10.2015.

In view of the peculiar facts noticed herein above, prayer in the petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Mewat.

Petition is disposed of.
