JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Prayer is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 343, dated 25.10.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 406, 420 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Ambala Cantt. District Ambala.

There are serious allegations against the petitioner having cheating the complainant-company for a sum of Rs. 35 lacs (Approx.) by way of commissions for having lifted 1400 quintal sugar from the manufacturers in the account of the complainant. The payment made to the manufacturer through the cheques were bounced, however, the manufacturer by deducting the equal amount from the account of the complainant stand satisfied whereas the complainant has been rendered remediless.

It is contended that the petitioner is in custody since 05.11.2015, therefore, prayer for grant of regular bail.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence, no case for grant of regular bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
