JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 439 Cr.PC for grant of regular bail to the petitioner Aditya @ Ata in case FIR No.735 dated 10.12.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 307, 506 of Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act registered with Police Station City Sonipat.

As per the eye witness account of complainant Mahender Singh his son Amit was waylaid by non applicant/co-accused Vikas accompanied by 10 other boys including the present petitioner and Vikas is alleged to have inflicted a knife injury on the back of the Amit while the others by fists and blows. Although the petitioner is not named in the FIR, however,

during investigation it is surfaced that he has inflicted kicks and blows on injured Amit who suffered four injuries including the one dangerous to life on his back.

It is contended that the petitioner is student of 10+2 and is in custody since 31.12.2015. Even the role attributed is of inflicting kicks and blows.

Learned State Counsel assisted by ASI Suresh Chander submits that after completion of investigation challan has been presented and custody period as well as role attributed to the petitioner is also not disputed.

Without going into the merits of the case, keeping in view the above and the custody period as well as the fact that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future, present petition is allowed and the petitioner Aditya @ Ata is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of learned CJM/Duty Magistrate, Sonipat.

Petition stands disposed of.
