The petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to register FIR under Sections 420, 406, 120-B IPC against respondent Nos.4 to 8 and their accomplices for cheating and defrauding the petitioner of his hard earned money in the name of share marketing under their scheme and guidance.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in this connection the petitioner has also moved a representation dated 06.11.2016 (Annexure P-3) and at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jalandhar to look into the matter and take appropriate action on their representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. Respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar is directed to look into the matter and in case it is found that any action is required, to take whatever action he deems

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necessary as per law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
