TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.118 dated 10.12.2013, under Sections 420/465/468/471/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Bhadson, District Patiala.

Counsel for the petitioner having argued the matter at some length prays for withdrawal of the present petition. He further submits that the petitioner would duly surrender within a period of three days from today. Directions are sought that if thereafter an application for regular bail is filed, the same may be decided forthwith.

As per submission and prayer made by counsel, the present petition seeking pre-arrest bail is dismissed.

Needless to observe that the protection granted by this Court in the light of order dated 11.01.2016 would as such cease to operate.

It is further observed that in case the petitioner surrenders before the Investigating Agency/Illaqa Magistrate within a period of three

days from today and thereafter files an application seeking regular bail, such application would be decided strictly on merits and the Court would make an endeavor to expedite the disposal of the same.
