The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.384 dated 31.10.2015, under Sections 420/467/468/471/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Amritsar City.

As per prosecution version, petitioner fabricated revenue documents regarding land of Daljit Singh by way of impersonating himself as Patwari Kuldeep Singh. Thereafter, such fabricated documents were produced before the concerned official of Oriental Bank of Commerce to secure a loan.

The allegations against the petitioner are serious in nature. That apart, it has gone uncontroverted that the petitioner, who had earlier in point of time himself held the post of Patwari had been dismissed from service in pursuance to a departmental inquiry having been conducted on similar allegations. The antecedents of the petitioner are not clean.

This Court does not find any infirmity in the order dated 04.12.2015 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar

declining the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
