The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 13 dated 13.01.2015 registered at Police Station Urban Estate, Rohtak, District Rohtak under Sections 498-A, 406, 34, 313, 304-B, 506 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is unmarried brother-in-law who had been arrested on 21.04.2015. The counsel urges that the challan has been presented and the trial is taking time. It has been urged that though the petitioner has been named in the suicide note but no specific allegations against the petitioner are there in the dying declaration.

Learned State counsel submits that 13 PWs have been examined.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
