The petitioner has been in custody since 09.06.2016, in a case registered at the instance of the complainant, namely Sanjiv Sharma, alleging that the petitioner along with 15-20 other persons ransacked his house and broke the household articles and his motor cycle.

It has been informed that similarly circumstanced co-accused of the petitioner has been granted the concession of bail.

Since no specific injury is attributed to the petitioner, he can be granted the concession of bail.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
