Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to provide adequate security and to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.5 to 8 with further direction to respondents No.2 and 3 not to harass and interfere in the peaceful life of the petitioner.

2. In response to notice of motion, learned State counsel has filed the reply by way of an affidavit of Jashandeep Singh Gill, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sunam. The same is taken on record.

3. A glance at the afore-said reply reveals that on the basis of complaint lodged by the petitioner an enquiry was conducted by Station House Officer, Police Station City, Sunam. On the basis of inquiry report submitted by SHO,

Police Station City, Sunam, the then Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sunam after recording the statements of both the parties, further submitted report dated January 27, 2016. According to the said report, the dispute between the parties is pending in the Civil Court at Sunam and the parties have undertaken that the decision so taken by the Court will be acceptable to them. It has also been reported that nothing came to light regarding apprehension of breach of peace thus, no further action is required to be taken on the application. Accordingly, the same was filed by Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur on February 01, 2016.

4. In view of reply filed by official respondents, instant petition has rendered infructuous. As such, the same is dismissed.

5. However, petitioner shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available to her under law.
