Petitioner-Pawan Kumar alias Sandeep has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.628 dated 12.07.2016, registered at Police Station Hisar City, District Hisar, under Sections 379, 414, 411 and 201 of Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case.

Mr. B.S.Virk, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

Police record has also been produced.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner has not been named in the FIR. The mohindra-pick up has not been recovered during investigation of the present case. Learned State counsel argues that the vehicle has been disposed of and only RC of the vehicle is stated to have been recovered from the present petitioner. He further argues that some

parts of the vehicle have been recovered from the co-accused. The petitioner has been in custody since 16.10.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
