JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J. (Oral)

By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.93, dated 05.09.2015, registered under Sections 307 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC'), at Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 21.07.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation. The petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and there is no specific allegation against the petitioner.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that though

in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation but she is not cooperating with the investigation.

Heard.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner, who is sister-in-law of the complainant has joined the investigation and no specific role has been ascribed to her, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 21.12.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
