The prayer in the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.44 dated 13.11.2015, under Sections 7/13/49/88 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, registered with Police Station State Vigilance Bureau, Hisar, District Hisar (**Annexure P-1**).

The petitioner is working as a Head Clerk in the Cooperative Societies, Hisar-1(III) and on a complaint lodged by Rajesh Kumar, Junior Auditor, Cooperative Societies, Hisar, the petitioner was caught red handed, accepting a bribe of Rs.2,000/- in a trap case.

It is contended that the petitioner is in custody since 14.11.2015 and investigations qua him are over.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by A.S.I. Dhyan Singh, concedes regarding the custody period and submits that after completion of the investigation, the challan is under preparation.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period and the facts as noticed above, this Court finds that petitioner/accused-Dharambir Singh deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.
