It comes out that the petitioner seeks re-transfer of the complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 from Amritsar to Ludhiana on medical grounds. In the circumstances, the petition is disposed of and the interim order passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court on 21.12.2015 is further extended to the extent that the personal appearance of the petitioner before the Amritsar court shall remain exempted. However, the petitioner shall have to appear before the Amritsar court if the Amritsar Court feels that his personal appearance is necessary for any specific purpose.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
