JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 73, dated 22.05.2015 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 420, 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Lambi, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, (Punjab) along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

2. In compliance of order dated December 21, 2015, report of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Malout, has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties

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have arrived at compromise with their free threat, without any pressure, voluntarily or coercion from any quarter. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 73, dated 22.05.2015 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 420, 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Lambi, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, (Punjab) and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
