JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of FIR No. 414 dated 17.08.2015 under Sections 420 IPC registered at Police Station Sector 34, Chandigarh (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 23.11.2015 (Annexure P-2)

2 Report of learned trial Court has been received, wherein, it has been categorically observed that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily,

without any pressure/coercion from any quarter. Even otherwise, matter involved in these proceedings is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. So, in view of circumstances narrated above as well as the observations made in cases reported as ***Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another***; 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052 and ***Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another (2014) 6 SCC 466***, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for the benefit of the parties and would certainly bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 414 dated 17.08.2015 under Sections 420 IPC registered at Police Station Sector 34, Chandigarh (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising out of the same are quashed qua petitioners.
