FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 09.02.2016 sent by learned Civil Judge, Junior Division-cum-Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Malout has been received, whereby, it has been informed that consequent upon death of complainant-Baljinder Singh son of Heera Singh his legal representatives comprising of his widow Baljit Kaur, son, Karamjit Singh and daughter Amandeep Kaur have effected a compromise with the petitioners Nishandeep Singh @ Sonu, Rajdeep Singh, Lovepreet Singh, Sukhwinder Singh by way of Annexure P/4 and that even during the life time of Baljinder Singh he has effected a compromise with the accused which is also placed on record by way of Annexure P/2.

Keeping in view the same and the fact that offences are not heinous in nature and that the parties belong to the same very village and that this compromise will go a long way to sort out the

differences between the parties and to bring about harmony and sense of brotherhood and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.41 dated 1.5.2012 under Sections 324, 341, 506, 34 IPC, (later on added Sections 323, 325, 427 IPC) Police Station, Kabarwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
