The prayer in this present petition filed under Section 482 of Cr. P.C is for quashing of FIR No. 13 dated 07.02.2014 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Sections 420/467/468/471 of IPC at Police Station Tallewal, District Barnala on the basis of compromise dated 17.11.2015 (*Annexure P-2*).

Report of the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Barnala has been received wherein it has been reported that the statements of the complainant and accused have been recorded and compromise has been effected between the parties. It is further reported that the said compromise is voluntary and is without any coercion, pressure or undue influence.

In view of the fact that the parties have amicably settled their property dispute, FIR No. 13 dated 07.02.2014 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Sections 420/467/468/471 of IPC at Police Station Tallewal, District Barnala and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, stand quashed on the basis of compromise dated 17.11.2015 (*Annexure P-2*).

In view of the above, the petition stands allowed.
